33RD COAST TO COAST RUN

SUNDAY 23RD JUNE 2019

The Coast to Coast Run is an event for Veteran, Vintage, & Classic Motorcycles & Scooters, including three-wheelers, built before 2000. The run will begin from the Cobb Gate Car Park, Lyme Regis, on the South Dorset coast, flagged off by the Mayor at 10am. (Sign-on from 8am).



It will then wend its way through Dorset and East Devon into Somerset, before taking a coffee break at the Chilthorne Domer Recreation Club near Yeovil, at about 11am.



Then it is on deeper into Somerset to a new stopping point for lunch this year – Dobbies Garden Centre on the east side of Shepton Mallet. After lunch the run makes its way west to Burnham-on-Sea on the North Somerset Coast.

The run ends on the South Esplanade in Burnham at around 3:30pm. Here the mayor will present the awards for the day at around 4pm.



The run normally attracts 150-200 bikes as entrants, riding a great variety of machines, plus 60-80 marshals, generally riding more modern bikes. So plenty to see.

Before the start of the run in Lyme, there will be tea, coffee, and breakfasts available at local establishments.

The run is organised by the Westland Classic Motorcycle Club, Yeovil, and any net proceeds will be passed on to the charity HEADWAY (SOMERSET) SOCIETY.

HEADWAY is a registered charity which provides aftercare for head and brain-injured patients.

The cost of entry is £15 (£25 on the day). Under 18s and Learners are Free. Volunteer Marshals are always needed, most welcome, and also Free.
