# REGULATIONS

## Coast to Coast

### 28<sup>th</sup> June 2020

1. The run is organised by the WESTLAND CLASSIC MOTORCYCLE CLUB in order to provide support for the designated charity - HEADWAY SOMERSET.
2. All Entrants, and Marshals, are required to sign-on, on the day, in Lyme Regis. This will take place from 8am at the venue that will be indicated in final instructions issued just prior to the event.
3. The event will be in the form of a PARADE from Lyme Regis to Burnham-on-Sea. Entrants will be set off at about 10am in small groups (as designated by the start marshal), with time breaks between the groups. There will be two intermediate stops – the first mid-morning for coffee, and the second for lunch. The finish, and award ceremony, will be in the Pier Street Car Park, Burnham-on-Sea. Marshals will be provided along the route to help guide the direction, they will NOT control traffic.
4. The event is open to scooters; motorcycles; combinations; & bike-based three-wheelers in the following classes – Veteran, Vintage, Post War Classics and bikes in manufacture up to the year 2000 (later bikes may be accepted, please contact the organiser) The total number of entrants may be restricted.
5. The fee for entry prior to the day of the event is £15. Cheques must be made payable to WESTLAND CLASSIC MOTORCYCLE CLUB. Entries on the day of the event will be accepted, subject to spaces being available, at a fee of £25. There is no fee for under 18's; Learners; or Marshals
6. For their own wellbeing all Marshals are required to indicate to the organisers (in confidence) if they have a medical condition which could cause problems if they are requested to be sited at remote junctions, etc. on their own.
7. FOR SAFETY'S SAKE, ENTRANTS MUST NOT OVERTAKE THE LEAD MARSHAL.
8. The awards will be presented at the finish of the event. The organiser's decision on the winners of the awards is final.
9. No entrant or marshal will be permitted to take part in the event unless they have signed the indemnification on the entry form. It is the entrants and marshals individual responsibility to ensure they follow the Highway Code, and comply with the laws of the land during their participation in this event.
10. All entrants and marshals must effect and maintain a policy of motor insurance, which is valid for this activity, in respect of the vehicle entered and used in the event, for the duration of the event. The vehicle used must conform to all relevant legislation, and have any applicable Road Tax and MoT Test certificate. The rider/driver must hold a current Driving Licence valid for their use of the vehicle in this event.
11. The Westland Classic Motorcycle Club reserves the right to cancel, or change, any part of this event, or the event in its entirety.
12. To comply with the Data Protection Act all entrants and marshals shall be aware that their details given on the entry form will be stored by electronic means. Whilst these details are kept confidential by the club they may be passed to third parties connected with the event, e.g. the programme printer and official photographer etc.
